Mr. Horwitz has responsibility for the GATX Portfolio Management and Procurement organization. This organization includes Railcar and Locomotive Portfolio Management, New Car Procurement, Secondary Markets and Materials Procurement. David began his career at GATX in 1995 as an Engineer, and over the last 29 years has spent significant time working with GATX's suppliers and customers in a variety of Fleet Management and Procurement roles. David also previously led GATX's Eastern Sales Region.

The Portfolio Management and Procurement organization is responsible for the risk adjusted return across GATX's existing rail fleet, and also to profitably grow via new car purchases and secondary markets acquisitions. The GATX fleet consists of 110,000 tank and freight cars, over 500 locomotives, and GATX generally acquires 3,000 – 6,000 railcars annually through long term supply agreements, and other new and secondary markets investments.
