In 1988, Curtis together with his father formed Great West Energy Ltd. which was later sold to Bow Valley and then resold by Bow Valley to Nova Gas Clearinghouse. Curtis played a variety of roles during the rapid growth of Great West Energy, including overseeing information systems, supply purchasing, and sales. He also played a key role in new market development. Curtis was a market maker at Novagas and was responsible for pricing decisions covering all regions of Canada. In 1994 Curtis left Novagas and co-founded Chandler Energy Inc. (CEI) and Chandler Energy Resources Inc. CEI soon became one of the largest marketers of Nat Gas in Canada, moving an excess of 1.5 billion cubic feet of gas each day to various customers in the US and Canada.

CEI was sold to NIPSCO industries Inc., an American gas and electricity utility in November 1996. Chandler Energy Resources developed an underground Natural Gas storage facility near Edmonton, Alberta together with its partners Dominion Energy and Sabine(Texaco). Curtis then formed Intercontinental Energy Brokers, incorporated in 1997, which became a leading gas and power broker in Europe and was sold to ICAP in 2003. Since then Curtis has been involved in many energy related projects and companies with an emphases on expanding PFLs operation in Naples, Florida.
